Press Release

Results of Voter Scoring on the fulfillment of elected officials
Performance against Priority Benchmarks for Pailin Province¹

Translated in December 03, 2010

A sample of 100 voters² from surrounding districts and the municipality of Pailin province (35% women) representative of communities including: forestry, land, non-governmental organizations, businesspersons, civil servants, students and farmers, reported on their satisfaction with the performance of Palin's elected officials in relation to implementing the priority benchmarks for the province. In the majority of cases these benchmarks were felt not to have been achieved.

The majority of voters scored achievement of benchmarks 'between not-at-all accomplished' to 'moderate achievement' including: provide a canal in Stung Trang commune, increase the salary for the village chief, commune chief and government officials in all departments in Pailin province.

Three benchmarks were scored by a majority of voters as 'moderately' or 'largely fulfilled' including: identify free markets for agricultural products, provide tarmac roads, bridges, and the regular payment of state teachers' salary.

Following constituent feedback, Pailin Provincial Councilor H.E. Mr. Kert Sothea, H.E. Ms. Ven Dara, and Pailin Provincial Deputy Governor Mr. Meav Samay said of the benchmarks. "The implementation of the benchmarks is the responsibility of provincial councilors, provincial authorities, and especially elected officials. And all problems raised in the forum will be considered and discussed in order to improve Pailin province."

The breakdown for the scoring made by voters on the accomplishment of benchmarks was as follows:

- 1 'Not-at-all' or 'slightly' accomplished (0% to 20%)
- 2 'Moderately' (21% to 40%)
- 3 'Average' (41% to 60%)
- 4 'Largely' (61% to 80%)
- 5 'Almost' or 'Completed' (81 to 100%)

The below table of results is the score given by voters toward the accomplishment of each benchmark, identified by voters as necessities for Pailin Province in 2009.

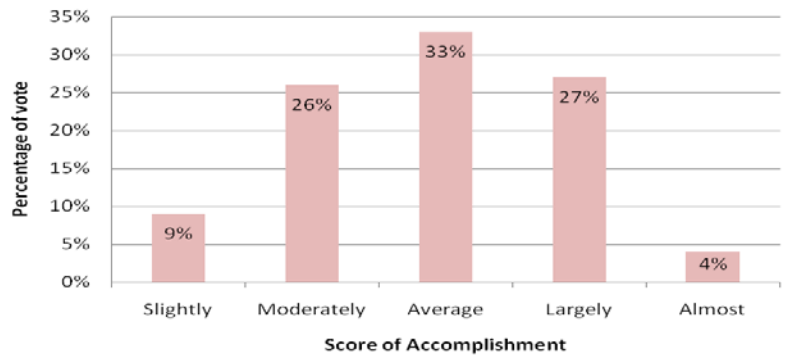

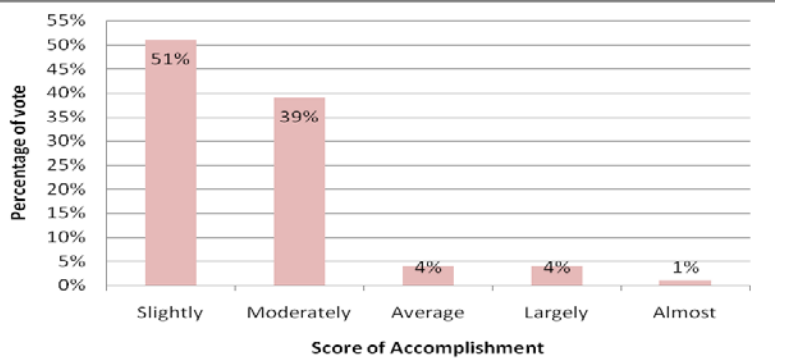

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5. Provide three tarmac roads and one bridge between 2010 and 2015

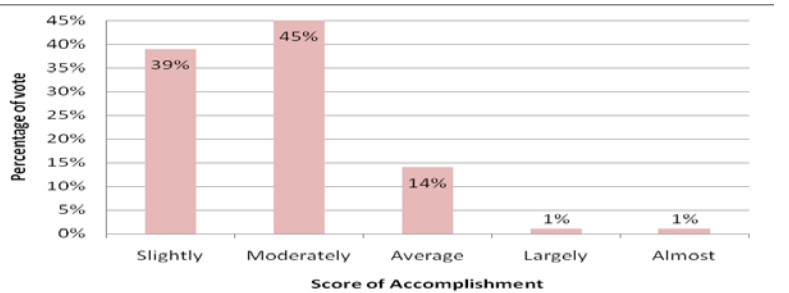
- The first road is in O Tavao commune from Pang Rolim village to Kracha Leu village (12 kilometres).
- The second road is in O Andoung commune from Thnol Keng village to Koun Damrei village in Stung Treng commune (18 kilometres).
- The third road is from Phnom Koy village to Sre Anteak village in Salakrao commune (8 kilometres).
- One bridge in Botangsou village in Boyakha commune.



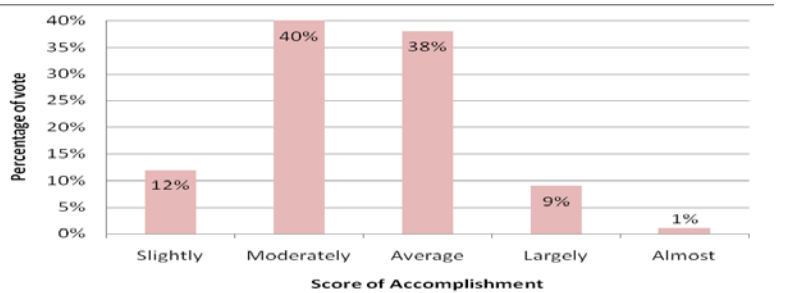
6. Increase the salary for the village chief and commune chief to 100% of the official salary. Increase salaries by 40% for government officials in all departments in Pailin starting from 2010.






7. Provide low interest loans (1% per month) for farmers in Pailin starting from 2010 to 2015.
